Dear Sister Kat,


This is in follow up to our recent conversation concerning the attached Temporary Restraining Order issued by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas, Fort Worth Division. As we discussed, in addition to the Order's application to all BLET members employed by BNSF, it is critical that all BLET Auxiliary officers and members follow and abide by the Court's Order. The Auxiliary's very name, and inclusion in the BLET's Bylaws could prompt the Court to seek sanctions against BLET if any of the officers or members of the Auxiliary are found to be in violation of the Order.

Although the Court has stipulated that BLET must take every action to ensure compliance, it should never be misconstrued as to whose instructions these are. They are the instructions of a Federal Court Judge and they should be taken very seriously; compliance is required.

Please distribute this cover letter and the attached directions/procedures to each of your subordinate Auxiliaries. You are also required to post both documents on your website and social media page(s).
